

## GOVERNMENT OF PONDICHERRY

## REVENUE DEPARTMENT

(G. O. Ms. No. 33, dated 23rd February 1987.)

## NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F. 5/4/65-GP, dated 11th January, 1965 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi and in supersession of the Government of Pondicherry, Revenue Department (Class III) Recruitment Rules, 1976 in so far as it relates to the post of Tahsildar issued in Revenue Department's Notification No. A 10393/74, dated 28-3-1976, save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'B' posts of Tahsildar, namely :—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Revenue Department, Group 'B' Post of Tahsildar Recruitment Rules, 1987.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Number of post, its classification and scale of pay.*—The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said schedules.

4. *Disqualifications.*— No person,—

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*—Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons;

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

Such of the officers as are assessed "Not suitable" for appointment to the said upgraded posts shall continue to be in the posts of Tahsildar (Group 'C') and their cases would be reviewed every year. |
| 12. In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer is to be made.  | <b>Promotion :</b><br>Deputy Tahsildar with 5 years' regular service in the grade and who have passed the departmental tests prescribed for the post of Tahsildar.  |



**Transfer on deputation :**

Officers holding analogous posts in the Revenue Department in the State of Tamil Nadu. (The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre posts held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years).

13. If a D.P.C./R.C. exists, what is its composition? **Group 'B' Departmental Promotion Committee :**

1. Chief Secretary — Chairman
2. Secretary to Government, Revenue Department, Pondicherry. — Member
3. Deputy Secretary to Government, Revenue Department, Pondicherry. — Member

**Note :** The proceedings of the Departmental Promotion Committee relating to confirmation shall be sent to the Commission for approval. If, however, these are not approved by the Commission a fresh meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee to be presided over by the Chairman or Member of the Union Public Service Commission shall be held.

14. Circumstances in which the Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment. Consultation with the Commission necessary while selecting an officer for appointment on transfer on deputation.
